Hello = *Dia duit*

(pr. = dee-a gwitch or dee-a ditch)

The response to the above greeting is *Dia is muire duit* (pr. = dee-a iss mwirra gwitch)

Yes = *is ea*

(pr. = sha)

No = *níl*

(pr. = neel)

How are you? = *Conas a tá tú?*

(pr. = cunnass ā taw too)

I'm fine = *Tá me go maith*

(pr. = taw may gó maw)

Thank you = *Go raibh maith agat*

(pr. = gó ruv maw h'aggutt)

Please = *le do thoil*

(pr. = lē dō hoil)

1 = *a haon* (pr. = ā hay-on)

2 = *a dó* (pr. = ā doh)

3 = *a tre* (pr. = ā tree)

4 = *a ceathair* (pr. = ā kyahir)

5 = *a cúig* (pr. = ā koo-ig)

6 = *a sé* (pr. = ā sha)

7 = *a seacht* (pr. = ā shact)

8 = *a hocht* (pr. = ā hoc-t)

9 = *a naoi* (pr. = ā nay)

10 = *a deich* (pr. = ā deh)

Music, fun, and food! = *Ceol, crac, agus bia!*

(pr. = kee-ole, crack ah-guss bee-a)

A hundred thousand welcomes to Ireland! = *Céad mile fáilte go hEireann!*

(pr. = cay-ad meela fawl-tcha gó air-an)

Cheers! = *Sláinte*

(pr. = slawn-tcha)

Goodbye (for now) = *Slán (go foill)*

(pr. = slawn (goh foil))
